




THE TRAINING KIT IS READY!

The partners believed it was necessary to create training materials aimed at youth workers who want to improve their daily practice, making it more inclusive, but who do not have the appropriate training or strategies to do so.

As partners found out, there is a demand for knowledge of models that guide youth worker's educational function and daily practice with young people - especially with NEETs - to motivate them to continue learning, enter the labour market or be more active and participatory in society. In addition, the partners have also identified the need to train all those working with young people in pedagogical strategies to promote young people's creativity, Digital Art and social inclusion issues.

This training kit has the main objective of training youth workers not only by providing theoretical knowledge on social inclusion and youth work, but also by providing them with the strategies, resources and techniques necessary to adapt them to their educational contexts and realities. Also, it will allow to increase interest in the subject, and to learn how to apply new methodologies and methods of non-formal and informal learning, both in groups and individually, adapted to the diversity of young people and the special needs of the Ni-Nis. It will contribute to the continuous improvement of their work to address the creative potential of young people, the potential of new technologies and the specific characteristics and needs of youth workers and their young people.





The course is structured in 3 modules:

1. Pedagogical strategies in non-formal and informal contexts to foster creativity and motivation of young children;
2. Digital Art: improving artistic and digital skills to enhance employability and lifelong learning;
3. Implementation and adaptation of new strategies in specific youth contexts.


The KIT will be available on our website with an interactive format in English, Spanish, Macedonian and Latvian, in an open and accessible way to all users.
